

THE MATH MINOR

Credit Hour Requirement: A minimum of 9 Math hours must be taken at the upper-division level; at least 3 hours must be at the 4000-level or above.; all upper division courses must come from the Department of Mathematics. A grade of C- or better is required for each course, and a 2.000 grade point average is required in *all* mathematics work attempted.

Courses Required of All Students

1. Calculus I (e.g., MATH 1300 or APPM 1350)
2. Calculus II (e.g., MATH 2300 or APPM 1360)
3. Calculus III (e.g., MATH 2400 or APPM 2350)
4. Discrete Mathematics (MATH 2001)
5. Linear Algebra (MATH 3130 or MATH 3135)
6. Plus two upper division MATH courses (at least one at the 4000-level*)

* Students who declared the minor prior to Fall 2014 may count MATH 3430 towards the 4000-level hours.
