THE MATH MINOR

Credit Hour Requirement: A minimum of 9 Math hours must be taken at the upper-division level; at least 3 hours must be at the 4000-level or above.; all upper division courses must come from the Department of Mathematics. A grade of C- or better is required for each course, and a 2.000 grade point average is required in *all* mathematics work attempted.

Courses Required of All Students

- 1. Calculus I (e.g., MATH 1300 or APPM 1350)
- 2. Calculus II (e.g., MATH 2300 or APPM 1360)
- 3. Calculus III (e.g., MATH 2400 or APPM 2350)
- 4. Discrete Mathematics (MATH 2001)
- 5. Linear Algebra (MATH 3130 or MATH 3135)
- 6. Plus two upper division MATH courses (at least one at the 4000-level*)

^{*} Students who declared the minor prior to Fall 2014 may count MATH 3430 towards the 4000-level hours.
