

## THE MATH MINOR

**Credit Hour Requirement:** A minimum of 12 Math hours must be taken at the upper-division level; at least 3 hours must be at the 4000-level or above.; all upper division courses must come from the Department of Mathematics. A grade of C- or better is required for each course, and a 2.000 grade point average is required in *all* mathematics work attempted.

### Courses Required of All Students

1. Calculus I (e.g., MATH 1300 or APPM 1350)
2. Calculus II (e.g., MATH 2300 or APPM 1360)
3. At least one\* of Calculus III (e.g., MATH 2400 or APPM 2350) or Discrete Mathematics (MATH 2001)
4. Linear Algebra (MATH 3130)
5. Plus three upper division MATH courses (at least one at the 4000-level)

\*Students should keep in mind that many upper division courses have Calculus III or MATH 2001 as a prerequisite. Taking only one of the two courses will limit a student's options for later courses.
