1.(e). $\int 2 \sin 2x \cdot (\sin x)^2 dx$

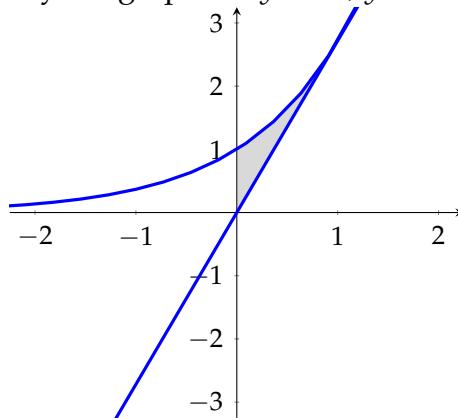
1.(f). $\int \frac{5x - 1}{(x - 1)(x - 2)} dx$
