

## THE MATH MINOR

**Credit Hour Requirements:** A minimum of 9 MATH hours must be taken at the upper-division level; at least 3 hours must be at the 4000-level or above. A grade of C- or better is required for each course, and a 2.0 grade point average is required in *all* mathematics work attempted.

### Courses Required of All Students

1. Calculus 1 (MATH 1300 or APPM 1350)
2. Calculus 2 (MATH 2300 or APPM 1360)
3. Calculus 3 (MATH 2400 or APPM 2350)
4. Intro to Discrete Mathematics (MATH 2001) or Number Systems (MATH 2002)
5. Linear Algebra (MATH 2130 or MATH 2135)<sup>i</sup>
6. Plus three upper-division MATH courses (at least one at the 4000-level<sup>ii</sup>)

<sup>i</sup>Students who took MATH 3130 may count the course as one of their upper-division MATH courses.

<sup>ii</sup>Students who declared the minor prior to Fall 2014 may count MATH 3430 as a 4000-level course.
