

Due to an error in printing, the first optional question on side B of your FCQ forms was deleted and a row of dots printed in its place. In addition, if there were a total of 24 optional questions, the 24th optional question is also missing.

We are very sorry for this printing error, which was due to a software update at Printing Services. The printing error was not discovered until processing of fall 2012 FCQs began this December.

With the first optional question missing on the FCQ form, a small percentage of students moved their responses out of position – putting their response to the second optional question into the first response row on side B, etc. If the first response row on side B has a 1-6 student response bubbled in (any response other than N/A), we suppressed all side B responses on that FCQ form, because we could no longer assume that the student's responses were assigned to the correct questions. This affected about 2% of all CU-Boulder FCQ forms returned to the FCQ Office. In addition, if there were any 1-6 responses in the 24th optional question response row, these were also suppressed (0.1%). Otherwise, we processed all as usual.
