A model theoretic solution to a problem of László Fuchs

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Problem 5.1 in page 181 of Abelian Groups by László Fuchs, asks to find the cardinals λ such that there is a universal abelian *p*-group for purity of cardinality λ , i.e., an abelian *p*-group *U* of cardinality λ such that every abelian *p*-group of cardinality λ purely embeds in *U*. In this series of talks, we will use ideas from the theory of abstract elementary classes to show that there are many cardinals where there is a universal abelian *p*-group for purity. Moreover, we will provide a complete solution to Fuchs' question below \aleph_{ω} except for \aleph_0 and \aleph_1 . We will introduce all the notions of abstract elementary classes needed to follow the argument of the main theorem and give plenty of algebraic examples to showcase them.
